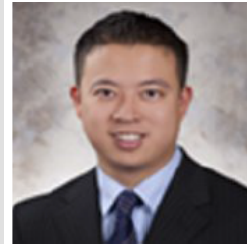


**John S. Fizer, MD; University of Utah, Rocky Mountain COEH**
