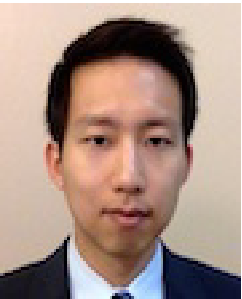
**Kenji Saito, MD, JD**

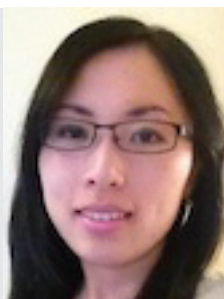
